The redwoods. - Met Mr & Mrs. Douglas Toffelmeier, Sr. at their farm at Sebastopol, California and drove through the redwoods. Mrs. Toffelmeier was Aunt Isabel, mother's aunt. Born Isabella May Cormack in the Orkney Islands off Scotland's north coast.
