1. Two 1916 photos of Paris Z., one in wedding dress. Two photos EACZ at the beach.
2. Two photos of 1905 Lewis & Clark Fair - Government Bldg. - night photo of warboat "Charleston". Oneita & Helen Jantzen as small girls - Carl, Emma, Oneita & Helen at Seaside, Oregon in posed picture in 1917. (Latter photo at O.H.S.)
3. Mrs. Dyche & mother Z in 1915. Mr. Luckey with grandson, (Bessie's), 1912. 1906 photo of JAZ & EAC. Another of same marked 1908 but same skirt as 1906 photo. 1915 photo of Gilbert-Luckey family (friends), 8 adults, 1 child. Photo labeled Oregonian Bldg and Marquam Bldg, but looks to be Oregonian Bldg and old Portland Hotel with the picture "flipped", or reversed, in printing.
4. JAZ in 1914 . (FINE) - Two of JAZ & EAC marked 1908 but same as on p. 3. EACZ in 1915 at beach in bathing suit and cap, socks. (FINE) Sam Street and Joe Gerber at Portland Rowing Club in 1915. (CLASSIC PHOTO) CRZ, LSS, JAZ, CCJ & JRG at P.R.Club 1915. JRG is Joseph R. Gerber, friend & printer.
5. River pictures - no date - CRZ's boat, SPRAY, with note "when Lew was here" (Lewis Bronaugh, friend of CRZ). SPRAY with mosquito netting - Camp of Roy (CRZ) and Paris Z. at mouth of Molalla River. Paris in bathing suit. Two photos of Rock Island.
6. Paris Z. & EACZ in canoe with note "When Sam & Sis lived at Yacht Club". Roy with 2 fish (25 & 35 lbs.) that he took at Eagle Creek. (Note says Roy says Jennings Lodge) 1916 picnic at Eagle Creek, 16 people, not identified. Photo of waterfall marked "On Highway" - Tellyn (?) and Paris in Vancouver BC at Adam Rentfrow's.
7. Hood River scenes - 1906 - Several in wagon, "just leaving King's (Z's cousins) to climb Mt. Hood. in June". JAZ in 1908 behind two horses and a mowing machine. 1908 photo of two women and a man, assume JAZ. Man with small rifle or air gun with note "on way to kill 50 diggers Frank along near Herman's" (Assume Herman Pregge) - 1908 photo of man and woman with boxing gloves faking sparing, JAZ ??.
8. Minerva Z (MZ) and Sam Street, 425 E. 50th St. 1915 - Two 1915 photos of Columbia River Highway. Three men in front of car with note "No postom - no coffee - nothing but spuds - just back from fishing Trask. Good luck."
9. Louise Dodson in 1902. Photo of JAZ & Harry Dodson in 1902. (Both Louise & Harry Dodson died of TB a few years later.) - Photo of Harry D. & George Canfield hunting. Great photo of two boys (assume one is JAZ) on bicycles about to leave for Vancouver, Washington. (GREAT PHOTO) Shows Gambrinus Gardens (Beer garden for local brewery) in background. While photo says Washington Street, it was 23rd & (now named) Burnside Streets when Henry Thiele's Restaurant was later. A RARE photo

10. JAZ in 1904 (or 1901?) Herman Pregge & Frank Phillippi on way up Mt. Hood in 1906. Harry (Dodson?) & Frank at Green Point in 1903. Photo looking across Green Point Canyon. Photo of Mud lake Mt. lookout.

11. Louise (Dodson) & Dowling girl 1901. GREAT photo of the slide at the Oaks Park, no date. Boy looking at baby in carriage. Photo of Bessie B. & Alice A. no date. Marion Plummer seated on bench, no date. JAZ's first auto a 1909 Oldsmobile. 1909 photo of JAZ & EAC playing croquet at 671 E. Salmon. 1909 photo six women playing croquet. One is Mable Cormack, EAC's cousin.

12. CRZ & Herbert (?) no date. JAZ with lawnmower at 357 E. 42nd N. Two unidentified tennis players. Bessie Luckey by fence rail. Two unidentified women. Large group at Lewis E. Bronaugh's in 1915. Four photos of Hayden island, no date, but JAZ holding child, nobody in swimwear. Guess about 1914.

13. Alfred Cormack & woman, 1908. Two women seated by railroad track, 1908. 1908 photo of man & woman at Forestry Bldg, JAZ??. Jim Cormack, Flora (second wife), Eva C. & Eliz C Z. seated by white water, 4th of July 1913.

14. Shepperd's Springs building 1908. 1914 photo fishing on Clear Creek with three women two men and John Jr. age 18 months. Photo of largest fish caught that day. Tiny fish and man unidentified. One of Clear Creek 1914 with "handy running board buffet".

15. GREAT photo of JAZ & John Jr age 2. Two of John Jr. at age 4 on first day of kindergarten, also showing Evelyn in "corral" (playpen). John Jr on 9/10/1916 in apple tree at 357 E. 42nd N. John Jr at 20 months, 33 lbs, at Seaside in photo with Paul Gilbert. At Seaside, Mr. Luckey holding Frank & John Jr. in lap. (Note by ERZL - Luckey family were Portland friends. Bessie Luckey married Harold Gilbert - bought piano from him.)

16. John Jr at 23 months. Also at 5 years. Two of JAZ playing horsey with Evelyn & John Jr. on back and EACZ watching. EACZ & John Jr at Seaside when he is age 5. EACZ holding Evelyn at age 3 months. (Pope studios, 1072 Hawthorne Avenue)

17. John Jr. at 8 months - 9 1/2 months - 11 months. Two photos at Seaside, John Jr. being held by Eva C.

18. Outing in car to Gordan (or Gorden) Creek. Four photos. Looks like EACZ, JAZ, John Jr. & Minerva (?) & older couple. Note stating "Trep took picture" that included JAZ.

19. Two of John Jr at 3 months, two more at 6 months. Family in front of 357 E. 42nd N. One of JAZ, EACZ & John Jr. (with hard to read note)

20. Four photos of John Jr. at Wilhoit Springs. Two at home, playing with wheel of car.

21. Easter, April 1916, Evelyn. Also Evelyn, John Jr & Margaret Cormack (Alfred's daughter). Five photos total.
22. Three of Evelyn at 2.
23. Two of Evelyn age 2 at Seaside, August 1916. Evelyn & John Jr. on 8/11/1916. Evelyn & EACZ on 8/10/1916 at Seaside. Evelyn & Aunt Louise & friends 8/11/1916.

30. Winter 1917. JAZ & 2 children on sled. (Evelyn & Betty?) Another (without snow) John Jr & Evelyn on porch with Evelyn holding kitty. 1920 photo at 1111 E. Couch of Evelyn, Jane & Betty.
31. 1917 Evelyn in snow. July 15, 1915 outing on Columbia River. Same date, John Jr. 2 yrs, Evelyn 8 months. CHRISTMAS 1915. at 357 E. 42nd N. From left: Lucinda Z., Paris Z., Alfred Cormack, John Z. (standing), Joseph Z. (next to JAZ), Louise Cormack holding (Margaret), James S. Cormack, Flora Cormack, Fred Schoppe (Louise's father), EACZ with baby Evelyn. (?), CRZ in back, EACZ in front in coat & MAZ & LSS.

43. St. Paul on Willamette River (CRZ kept a boat there), total of four photos. Unidentified other than JAZ & friends. One is labeled Maggie & Will Rentfrow.
44. Two small photos of Battleground Lake 1919. Three 1919 photos at St. Paul with Cormacks, Zs and Rentfrows. People are named in middle picture, but bottom photo is clearer.
45. Two small photos of Vancouver 1919. GOOD photo of Lucinda & Joseph Z "On the Ranch". Pope Studio photo of EACZ, John Jr (2 yrs 8 months) and Evelyn (3 months). JAZ & EACZ "Only engaged she says - and the year was 1911".
46. Four photos at St. Paul, 1920. Jantzens & Zehntbauers and Rentfrows and Zehntbauers. From left: Paris Z, ??, JAZ, MAZ, ??, Emma J. CCJ, EACZ.

82. Evelyn & Betty in surf at Cannon Beach in 1920. Roy & Paris off for New York City in Nov. 1920. 1920 two autos leaving plant for Seaside. John Jr. (??) fishing on Trask with a fine one.

83. Big snow of 1917, two photos. Z family in front of cabin at cannon Beach in 1920. Car on the "Narrow Hill, Kalama" (Could be Roy's)

84. One of two women in snow - CRZ in clown costume - Good photo of CCJ, Emma, Oneita and Helen Jantzen. - CRZ's home - Picnic on (?) river. Nerdy (Minerva), Roy & Paris "On the River"

85. Four 1917 photos at Crater Lake. 1917 photo with EACZ, Minerva, Sam & JAZ with note "We had nice young rabbits for dinner that day."

98. Six GREAT photos taken in December 1920 by Roy. All seem to be in Purdin. Missouri with plenty of good notes by either JAZ or CRZ or both. IMPORTANT.
99. Six photos on Roy's trip. Four at Uncle George Rentfrow's with his wife Luella, two at cousin Myrtle's (Rentfrow).
100. Four New York City photos, including one of Paris feeding a squirrel.
101. Five more NYC photos - One of Paris - two of harbor - one of Woolworth Bldg.
102. Three more NYC photos. including one of Roy & Paris and a Mr. & Mrs. Khouri in Prospect Park Jan 16, 1921. - Evelyn's class at Kerns school. Evelyn in second row with long curls & dark dress. - Omaha 1920 (see page 96.)
103. Mt. Defiance 1903 with JAZ, Harry D. Louise D, Minerva mother. - 330 6th street, 1904 five people. Two more 1920 photos in Omaha, at Aunt Lize's & Uncle Lew's. Two 1911 photos in woods at Portland. Three men camping across from Beacon Rock on Columbia, Melvin Fell (John Dodson's brother-in-law) on left, Billy (??) on right. Must be JAZ in center.

104. King's place in Hood River, undated. Kings related to Rentfrows and Dunns. Three photos of Roy & his first racing boat, "COMET". One photo in snow.

105. Roy & Ben in "good old ABC 17 foot Peterborough" canoe. 1909 fishing in B.C. - Roy's boat Sam & Minerva and another couple. Photo of either JAZ or CRZ "courting".

106. On top of Pike's Peak, Sept. 5, 1920 with JAZ in passenger seat. Bldg at Pike's Peak. Unidentified man holding fish.

107. Frank & Roy with rabbit in Eastern Oregon. Big picnic "Way up Gordon Creek". Above The Dalles with Columbia River in background. Two men sawing large tree at 435 50th St. E. - Appears to be Roy and another man.

108. Photo at Roy's including man in uniform, probably Harry (JHZ). Picnic eating watermelon. Driving from Hood River through tunnels in Columbia River Highway. Gordon Creek picnic. Carl & Emma at "Sam & Sis's" (A repeat picture).
