127. Five 1930s photos of Central Oregon. One on Skyline Trail, another of Z children camping at Lake DeNude; two with JAZ and Paul Striebel, first caretaker at the Metolius house.

128. Spring 1931 tornado picture showed damage at Heising's. Major wreckage!! Two more photos labeled 1934 show Roy Z & Winifred Thomas with a huge goose and Winifred at Suttle Lake petting a deer.

129. More pictures at Three Fingered Jack. See page 122 for more including some identification. 1929 or 1930. Also two Metolius pictures with EZL note that it may be 1930. No bridge across Metolius and people were crossing on a log.

130. More Central Oregon. Two of the Metolius house. Two at Big lake. One of a bear shot by Paul Striebel, the caretaker.

131. GREAT OLD PICTURE OF ZEHNTBAUER FAMILY AT PURDIN, MO. From left: John, Joseph, Minerva, Roy, Lucinda and Harry. A 1923 photo of Minerva leaving her cottage in Honolulu. 132. Another photo of Sunday picnic at "Jack's Shack" on Lewis River. Looks like a repeat of photo on page 71 of this album. From left: Top row, Pearl Dodson, J. E. Cormack, Alf Cormack, EACZ, Jack Dodson, with Evelyn in front of him; front: Jane Z, Annie Cormack (Mrs. J. E.), Betty & John Jr. Another picture with the same group. Photo of a birthday party with names of children included. Evelyn, Betty & Jane Z, plus Jean Cormack, Alf's daughter. Evelyn noted that the only one that took a decent picture was Jean Cormack. Another of ??, John Jr, Joe Gerber & JAZ.

133. 1934 photos. One of Winifred "Tommy" Thomas holding white goose (same as on page 128.), Another of Winifred with deer. One of Evelyn, now with short hair. One of three people in front of Metolius house. One of Metolius power house.

134. Two post cards from the Petrified Forest in Arizona. Two of JAZ changing a flat on Santiam Highway in May, 1935 with ERZ watching. One of ERZ. Another of Karl Vollmoeller from Berlin in May 1935. (He was the German Licensee later)

135. Three more of JAZ, one changing tire, one by car, one by tree. (EYL took pictures??) Studio photo of John Jr as a child (maybe 2 years). Another of JAZ leaving an airplane. Also a postcard of the Redwood Inspection Station.
