1. Jan 1925 - CRZ, EACZ, Paris Z, Minerva Z and Z girls on front porch. Another of same group, except JAZ on right in photo as CRZ took picture. This is preparing for trip to the Orient. Two photos at the Admiral Oriental Line dock in Seattle on Jan 27, 1925. One photo of Jane in front yard when family preparing to leave.
2. Another at the dock on Jan 27, 1925, noting it is pier 40. A photo of some of the other passengers, who are identified. One of Capt. Gibson, who died in Manila. One of seagulls.
3. Two shots of Jane. Two shots of John Jr. & friends. One labeled (L to R): Lawrence Dosey; Willard (Will) White; John Jr.; Clarence (Clarey) White; and Joe Ahern.
4. A May 1925 shot of Evelyn & Betty dressed on bunny costumes for a ballet recital. EACZ made costumes. Two May 1925 shots of John Jr. & Lawrence (Dosey?) in a canoe looking for an entrance to Ross Island lagoon.
5. Five photos of Chas. Hall (family friend) with Z children and with Eva in Jan 1925. A fine shot of Laurelhurst Lake with waterfowl in Jan 1925.
6. One of Jane Z, One of Betty Z. One of Betty Raymond, family friend. One at Laurelhurst lake in Jan 1925 Z girls, Minerva Z and Murray (?)
7. Orient trip. Five photos (or cards) in Canton, China.
8. Five more Canton photos.
9. Four Hong Kong photos. Two in front of Repulse Bay Hotel. One of them of JAZ & EACZ, Another of Mr. Lincoln, EACZ and Mr. & Mrs. Snowden.
10. One Hong Kong photo. Three Canton photos, with JAZ & EACZ in separate rickshaws.

12. Four more Shanghai photos.
13. Four photos in Tokyo One of JAZ & EACZ standing in front of hotel. Another of them seated. Another of EACZ & woman seated. This hotel may be a Frank Lloyd Wright bldg.?
14. Three photos at Tor Hotel in Kobe, Japan. Two with people. One of S. S. California at Kobe.

21. Back to the Orient trip. Four in Yokohama. Another of group on board ship. includes JAZ & EACZ.
22. Four more trip photos. Two of Buddha. Location not noted.
23. Three Canton photos. One at Hotel Tor, Kobe with Mrs. Lang, EACZ and Miss Good.
24. One of JAZ & two Seattle men in swim suits. Two of Canton, two of arriving in Manila.
25. Six photos in the Philippines. Manila harbor and the road to Baguio, the summer capitol.
26. Five more photos in Baguio.
27. Three more Baguio photos, one including EACZ. Photo of EACZ & Mrs. Coe playing shuffleboard of the S. S. Pres. Pierce.

42. Two more of family in Paso Robles pool. Chinese post card. In car on way to Grand Canyon.. John Jrs' Tokyo boat in the Willamette.
